



## FIN FITTED TO 'BBDG

CONCORDE G-BBDG was reunited with its tailfin at the Brooklands Museum on June 7, as work to complete reassembly of the Mach 2 airliner continued apace.

The delicate operation was undertaken by a group of Brooklands Museum Concorde volunteers, including several former British Airways engineers, and crane operators from J. Thomas (Southern) Ltd of Henfield, West Sussex.

The Brooklands Concorde will close to visitors from June 18 so that fitting-out of the interior exhibition can begin. This work is expected to be completed by the beginning of August, when the aircraft interior will open again for the start of the holiday season. When completed, G-BBDG will be the only Concorde in South-east England that is accessible to the public at close quarters.
